JULY 4 CELEBRATION

GLENSIDE, PA. ATRO members and fans will be among the thousands joining and participating in the community's three-tier July 4 celebration, a Monday event for all age groups sponsored by the non-profit Greater Glenside Patriotic Association (GGPA).

America's 246th birthday will be marked locally with Glenside's huge, Grand, Glorious, **Patriotic Parade**, among the country's oldest July 4th marches and the largest Independence Day parade in the Greater Philadelphia area. Starting time is 4 p.m. with participants heading from North Penn VFW Post 676 in Glenside, east along Jenkintown Rd., south on Easton Rd. and east along Waverly Rd. to Renninger Memorial Park.

A traditional **America the Beautiful Fireworks Spectacular**, an admission-free event, is set for 9 p.m. above the athletic fields of the Abington Senior and Junior High Schools, west of Highland Ave. and south of Susquehanna Rd. Free parking will be available on a limited basis in school parking areas on a first-come, first-served basis.

Holiday festivities will begin with a **Children's Program** at Renninger Park, Keswick Ave. and Waverly Rd., starting at 10 a.m. Decorated bikes, wagons, strollers and other youngster conveyances will be judged, followed by races and field events. Free refreshments will be served to conclude the program.
